Merrill Lions Club Vision Screening

On September 24 & 25, the Merrill Lions Club will offer a FREE VISION SCREENING for all students at Trinity. The screeners use an electronic scanner to determine the presence of as many as six eye disorders. This scan usually takes less than one minute. No eye drops are used and NO physical contact is made.

In order to have your child screened, you **must complete and sign the purple Consent Form** that was sent home. Consent forms must be returned to the office by September 17.

Following the screening, parents will be notified **ONLY** if it is recommended that your child has a follow-up eye exam.
