Drop Off and Pick Up

The drop off and pick up area in back of the school is a very busy place before and after school. If you are getting out of your car, whether it is to help your child carry something, walk a child in, or any other reason, please leave the car line and pull off to the south side of the parking area. In the morning, a single line is pulling through and dropping off right by the door. In the afternoon, a double line has students being released to parents. If you stop to walk to the door, you back up everyone, so please, pull out of line and park. Remember that anyone picking up your child must understand and follow these procedures, and also should have your tag in your windshield or on your visor. Following these simple steps will keep everyone safe and keep the lines moving.
