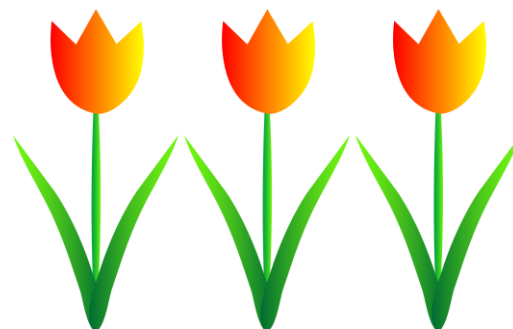
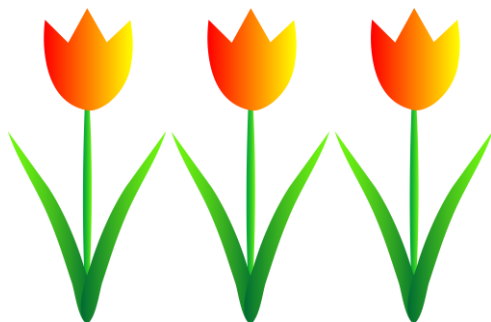

## **News from Wisconsin Valley Lutheran High School**

We are currently accepting applications for 2019-2020.

WI Valley has now joined the WI Parental CHOICE Program through which eligible families may send their students to The Valley **tuition free**. At The Valley, this year and next year, students may qualify at all grade levels for incoming, transfer, and current students. Families of students who are a part of the CHOICE Program at the elementary or middle school level, do not need to re-qualify for eligibility, but do need to apply to the WI CHOICE Program as they have each year.
