## Administrator's Message

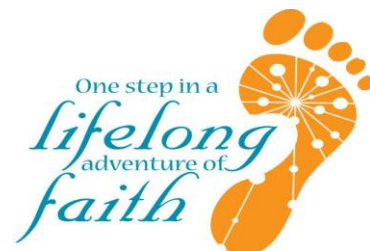

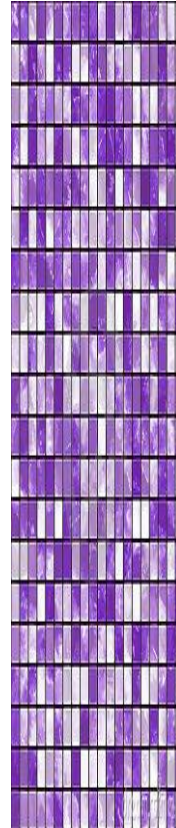
## FAITH5
