The last day that the scrip box will be available for sales at school is **Friday, May 31**. After that, you may purchase scrip in the church office during the week and before and after the weekend services.

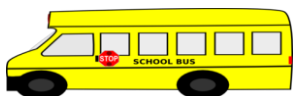
REMEMBER! If you purchase \$3500 in scrip before April 30, 2019, you will receive **\$100 OFF** your tuition for 2020-2021!
