Bake Sale

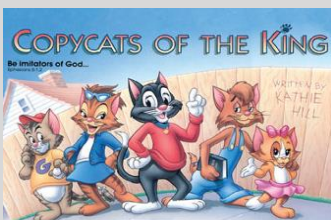
