### FOR NEW STUDENTS:

You will need a registration packet, which includes the forms to fill out. They are available in the school office.

### Please note the deadlines:

**April 21** – School Choice sign-up must be complete

**April 28** – Tuition Assistance Application must be turned in to office

**May 31** – Due date for online registration, all forms & first tuition payment to be turned in to office

## FAITH-FOCUSED QUESTIONS TO GET YOUR CHILDREN TALKING

Sometimes the best way to get your children involved in a great conversation is to begin with a question that gets them thinking. Here are seven questions, one for each day of this week. Give them a try! You just might be amazed by what you learn about your child!

8. What was the kindest thing you said or did today? Who needs an extra dose of your kindness?
9. Are there any things you said or did today that you need to ask for God's forgiveness?
10. Did you notice if anyone was having a rough day today? How did you help them?
11. Who did you talk to about Jesus today?
12. Did you ask anyone if they needed you to pray for them today?
13. Did Jesus put anyone on your heart today at school?
14. Was there a need that you saw and how did you or could you meet it?
