Trinity School has an opportunity to become a School Choice (voucher) school beginning in 2015-16. This gives you, the parents, the opportunity to send your child to Trinity Lutheran School completely free of charge if you fall within certain income guidelines.

The State of Wisconsin supports this program through the issuance of vouchers to schools. Schools are selected to become Choice Schools based in part on the number of applicants. Schools with the greatest number of applicants are awarded vouchers for students applying. Therefore, it is very important that we receive as many applications as possible from both students already attending Trinity School and from the community.
