Volleyball Players

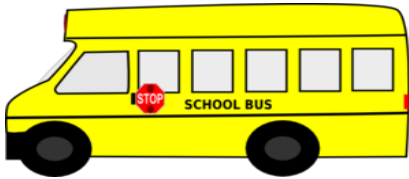
Expect a summer mailing in July with game & practice schedules. Practices will begin around August 15.
