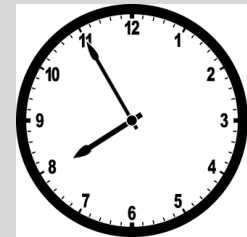
ADMINISTRATOR'S MESSAGE

NEW THIS YEAR!!

For children who are currently enrolled at our school, you will need just the one page sheet that explains how to register. You will need to complete some steps in FastDirect, then you will be able to print all the forms that must to be filled out and returned. Please note that if your child is entering Grade 6, you will also need to turn in updated immunization records prior to the beginning of the year.

IF YOU HAVE A CHILD WHO IS A NEW STUDENT ENTERING KINDERGARTEN OR ANY OTHER GRADE:

You will need a registration packet, which includes the forms to fill out. They are available in the school office.

Please note the deadlines:

April 21 – School Choice sign-up must be complete

April 28 – Tuition Assistance Application must be turned in to office

May 31 – Due date for online registration, all forms & first tuition payment to be turned in to office
