Earn a Tuition Discount!

The time is up for buying scrip to qualify for a tuition discount for next year's fees, but as of May 1, 2016, the window of opportunity to buy starts over.

If you purchase \$3500 in scrip by April 30, 2017, you will receive a discount of \$100 on your tuition for 2017-18.

You can buy scrip in the school office or the church office and also at weekend church services.

Effective immediately, the NSF charge from all Trinity School agencies will be \$30.00.

SUMMER DAYCARE

Planning for summer at Trinity Christian Daycare is underway! If you need daycare for your child this summer please call Kerri at 715-536-4011 to reserve a spot! Your child may come on an occasional, part-time, or full-time basis, but must be enrolled to attend.

During the summer months students are divided into groups according to their grade, and do age appropriate activities. Field trips include weekly summer library programs, swimming trips, Council Grounds, bowling, picnics at local parks, classes at the MARC, trips to the new Aquatic Center, Tee Ball, and more.

We are open 6-6 every day except July 4th and August 5th. Beginning June 1st prices are \$26 for a full day, and \$15 for a half day (5 hours or less). If there is more than 1 child in the family they receive a 20% discount.

***Due to our college workers heading back to school in mid-August we are often short staffed. If we do not have enough staff present to properly supervise all of our students, we may not be able to accept Summer Playground students the last week or two of summer.

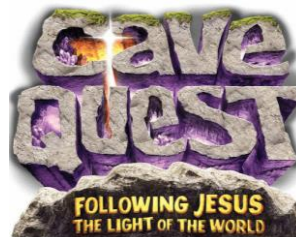
