


Winter Weather

Whatever what the calendar says, winter is upon us. Here are a few items to remember to help the snowy days go smoothly:

1. All students in kindergarten through eighth grade must have hats, mittens, coats, and boots at school every day. All go outside daily unless the weather dips below zero.

ATTENTION PARENTS:

It has been brought to our attention that there are a couple of cases of head lice reported at our school. This problem can be controlled if found and treated early. We strongly encourage you to check your child's head tonight for live lice or nits (eggs).

Under close inspection, you will see nits as small silvery eggs attached to individual hairs close to the scalp. They do not move easily or blow away like dandruff would. Live lice are small, flat, wingless bugs with stubby antennae and 6 legs.

If lice is found, please treat your child with a lice killing shampoo and thoroughly clean the household. Please call the health department, (536-0307), if you have any questions. Thank you for your cooperation.
