Trunk - to - Trunk



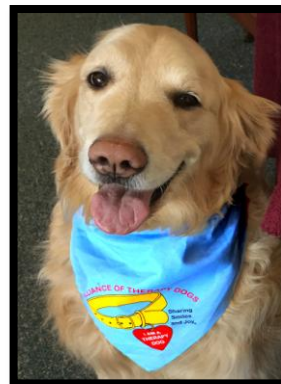
