

Late Pick-up Policy

School is dismissed at 2:55. Parents who pick up their children by care are expected to be here by 2:55. Children who are told to walk home will need to be gone by 3:00. Children who are not picked up or gone by 3:05, will be escorted to the after school care room, where they will be supervised until parent or caregiver arrives. They will be allowed to call a parent or caregiver to be certain that someone is on the way to pick them up. Parents will be charged the same rate as After School Care for late pick-ups.

* First late pick up – verbal reminder to parents

* Second late pick up- written reminder

* Third late pick up- \$3.00 fee charged if picked up prior to 4:00 or \$5.00 after 4:00.

When to keep your

children home from school



Your child's health is of major importance to all of us. Children showing signs of illness must be kept home for their comfort and their classmate's health. **Please do not send sick children to school!** The school reserves the right to decide when a child is unable to participate in class due to health or injury. You are expected to keep your child home for the following reasons:

1. fever above 100 degrees within the past 24 hours
2. unusual spots or rashes on the skin
3. continuous mucus from the nose accompanied by upper respiratory symptoms
4. if they are fussy, cranky or generally not themselves
5. diarrhea
6. vomiting for any reason within the past 24 hours
7. symptoms of a communicable illness (sniffles, reddened eyes, sore throat, headache, or abdominal pain)
8. a child should not return until they can participate in all indoor and outdoor activities.

After School Pick Up of Students

All students being picked up by parents in cars must be picked up in back of the school. After 2:55 dismissal, students will wait behind safety cones, supervised by both an adult staff member and a student safety patrol. Parents are to form two vehicle lines and wait for the teacher in charge to dismiss students to their car. For safety reasons, please put your cell phone out of sight while in the car line. Supervision ends at 3:05. After that time, students will be taken to after school care. A fee for late pickup will be applied.
