Bread & Butter & ½ pint milk of choice is served with each meal.



FROM THE PRINCIPAL



Attendance Policy

Wisconsin Law requires school age children to attend every day that school is in session unless health does not permit attendance. **When a student will be absent from school the parent is to call the school office by 10:00 a.m. on that day.** The call should state the reason for absence. If the reason is illness, please state the type of illness.

No student will be excused during the school day to walk home alone if he/she becomes ill. Arrangements will need to be made to have a parent or guardian pick that student up from school.

Students may only be absent a maximum of 10 school days a year. Also, if a student is tardy 3 times per quarter the teacher will keep the child for 15 minutes after the end of the school day to make up the lost time. Perfect and excellent attendance will be recognized at the end of the year

Immunizations



All students attending Merrill public and parochial schools must meet the immunization requirements for their age/grade level before being allowed to enter school (unless you have filed a religious or personal conviction waiver).

If your child has not received the immunizations required by the Wisconsin School State Statute 252.04, you will need to either contact the Lincoln County Health Department at 536-0307 or take your child to your family doctor for their immunizations.

Plan ahead to attend our first Chapel service on the first day of school, September 1st.
