Did you know Parents can deduct Private School Tuition?

The tuition tax deduction is NEW in Wisconsin and many parents may be unaware that such expenses are deductible in 2014.

Last year, WCRIS worked with legislators to make this deduction a reality for private school families. This is a great opportunity for parents as they are writing tuition checks for the coming term. Parents/guardians are eligible for a maximum deduction of \$4,000/child in grades K-8. Per the instructions, any amount spent on tuition and book fees are eligible for the deduction. All expenses incurred after January 1, 2014 are eligible. Attached to this newsletter is the Dept. of Revenue Schedule PS – Private School tuition -1NPR form. Only tuition and book fees paid directly by families qualify. Tuition Assistance and Scholarship money paid on accounts do not.
