Attendance Policy

Wisconsin Law requires school age children to attend every day that school is in session unless health does not permit attendance. **When a student will be absent from school the parent is to call the school office by 10:00 a.m. on that day.** The call should state the reason for absence. If the reason is illness, please state the type of illness. No student will be excused during the school day to walk home alone if he/she becomes ill. Arrangements will need to be made to have a parent or guardian pick that student up from school. Students may only be absent a maximum of 10 school days a year. And tardy 3 times per quarter.
